2017 Pastor's (Director of Ministry) Report

And 2018 Forecast

It may be the heading at the top of the page, Pastor's (Director of Ministry) Report, that may initially get your attention. However, as a member of Fairview, a regular attender or even an occasional guest/visitor, you are most likely aware and quite informed by now why that heading appears this way. Pastor Mark Atkinson's announced resignation/retirement in last year's Pastor's Report, due to health reasons, although sad and somewhat untimely, for both he and the Fairview Community, appeared initially to be a 'normal' announcement. Considerable planning and thought soon began as to how the Fairview Community would show its appreciation and affection to Pastor Mark for his, (along with wife Lois Ann), 11 years of faithful ministry at Fairview and to the Savior and Lord Whom he served – Jesus Christ. The last Sunday in August, (8.27.17), was to be the Farewell Luncheon.

The date of Tuesday, July 25, 2017 changed everything; Pastor Mark was rushed by ambulance to the Brandywine Hospital due to a severe attack of pancreatitis. Due to the very serious nature of Pastor Mark's health status and future prognosis, the Session held a special Called Session Meeting on Sunday, July 30 to announce the cancellation of the farewell luncheon and to collaboratively seek a path, (and person), to 'stand in the gap.' Through steady and positive teamwork, prioritizing plans and plain, old-fashioned hard work, the ministry mission and vision of Fairview EPC has and is functioning at the expected God honoring and Christ-focused level members, friends and guests have come to appreciate, value and expect.

I prayerfully and enthusiastically accepted that 'call,' and, since this past July have been engaged in worship planning, preaching and securing retired pastors to 'fill our pulpit,' congregational oversight, visitation and facilitating the Sunday morning adult small group study etc. etc., which will give you, the reader, a partial glimpse as to what's been happening at Fairview EPC these past six months. This past November the Session and I entered into a six month covenant, (contract), to bring more efficiency and presence to the pastor's office while concurrently our Pastor Search Team is engaged in the work of securing a new pastor.

I offer that 'reflection moment' to set the framework for what I believe the Lord has laid upon my heart and mind to share with you, as together, we 'cast a vision' – one that I'm calling **TRUSTING GOD During Transitions.**

My key scripture verses for this next part of the report are found in Proverbs 3:5-6, which says, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge (submit) to him, and he will make your paths straight." Hopeful, powerful and trustworthy words straight from God's Word – the Bible. Friends, I believe and can bring personal testimony that believing and embracing these words is a tremendous boost to one's walking by faith and experiencing God's leading while anticipating His answers to individual and church-wide prayer requests.

Fairview EPC is currently in a time of transition, but, it is also an adventurous, exciting and interesting time too! For example, we fondly recall a series of 'special, ministry moments' this past year, such as our Easter and Christmas Cantatas; an afternoon concert featuring portions of Handel's **Messiah** with excellent soloists, accompanied by a good turnout of Fairview and community singers; an enthusiastic VBS program, coordinated by Val Petrie and staffed by dedicated Fairview members; a special and emotionally filled dedication of our picnic tables following the worship service on October 29, as Fairview expressed appreciation and love to Patrick Finch, who achieved his Eagle Badge for this goal attainment. That moment is so significant since earlier that month, (October 4), Patrick was involved in a horrific auto accident and his presence that day – 25 days after the accident, was truly an answer to many prayers, starting with the word **TRUST**. These are representative examples, and, I'm sure you may have your own 'special ministry moments' of 2017 at Fairview.

Now, to a 'peek' at 2018 for a few moments through the lens of Proverbs 3:5-6. One, 'big picture point' I wish to share with you for 2018 and for the ministry at Fairview.

• TRUST GOD IN TIMES OF TRANSITION (referenced previously): How done? For instance, we (1) remember what His word teaches; (2) find peace with God; (3) choose love and faithfulness; (4) submit to Him our desires and plans; (5) live in awe of the Lord and run from evil; (6) fear (respect) the Lord.

At times I'm sure each of us this past year have asked a question similar to this, "What is God's will for Fairview? (Note: I have). But, in asking that question, may I suggest that each of us think back to some recent, past experience when you wondered, "Is this God's will?" Friends, we can look back and see what God did in our lives and know that was indeed His will. But, we can't look forward and 'see' God's will. It is **TRUSTING in GOD** that His timing, His person, and His plan is infinitely better than any plan you or I could ever imagine.

I graciously 'thank you' for the awesome privilege and honor it is to be 'about the Lord's work in His vineyard at Fairview!'

Board of Deacons

Deacons are called to serve and minister with sympathy and compassion to all those in need within our congregation and those in the community of faith. We seek to follow the example of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ as we serve others.

Your current board of Deacons is:

The deacons meet in January, March, May, September and November. Once a year we have a joint meeting with Session.

Responsibilities and cares of the Deacons are:

- 1. Praying for the members of the congregation and their loved ones.
- 2. Serving communion to homebound members, along with a member of Session.
- 3. Providing flowers for luncheon tables after funerals.
- 4. Connecting and caring for homebound church members with phone calls, visits, and gifts at Christmas and Easter time.
- 5. Reaching out to members of their flock by sending cards periodically at special times through the year.
- 6. Gifts are given to newborns, usually a stuffed animal lamb that sings "Jesus Loves Me."
- 7. Gifts are given to newlyweds, typically a pewter bread plate.
- 8. Organizing meals for members of the congregation with medical/financial needs.
- 9. Continuing the prayer shawl ministry, providing hand knitted or crocheted shawls for members of the congregation as needed.
- 10. Coordinating the Angel Tree at Christmas by selecting a family or mission and coordinating donated gifts from the congregation.
- 11. This past year we supported the continuation of the Trunk or Treat event at Halloween.
- 12. We also coordinated a Christmas Brunch after the Cantata on December 10, 2017. Thanks to the efforts of the congregation and Deacons, a special time of Christmas fellowship was enjoyed by those in attendance. It is our hope that a new "fellowship" small group will form and take over these types of events.
- 13. This year we also led the initiative and funding to continue the mission of sending cookies on Valentine's Day, "Fairview Far Away Box," sending care packages of cookies to our students away at college.

Currently, the deacons have funds of \$8,526.21 in an account for needs that arise. There is a special offering collected from the congregation on the fourth Sunday of each month that goes to the Deacons' fund.

The Deacons prayerfully consider all requests that are presented to them and seek guidance and discernment from the Lord in these decisions. Please continue to pray for us as we seek to serve in His name.

Missions

The Evangelical Presbyterian Church spells out specifically the first duty of the Church. The statement concludes, "...The Church must never confuse its primary task of evangelism (the Gospel) with the fruit of faith (good works)." This affirmation tells us that in addition to being evangelists ourselves, we need to give help and support to those whom God sends to full time service for Him.

Each individual mission we pledged to support in 2017 received that support from us. We praise God that we were able to do that. We have been able to make donations to The Evangelical Presbyterian Church missions programs and continue to look for ways to support EPC missions efforts in addition to our legacy FEPC missions.

A new Elder has taken over the responsibility of the committee. Many thanks to Greg Baxter for leading this committee for the first half of 2017 as Elder in Charge. In addition to the new Elder in charge a mission's committee has been formed to help make decisions and keep in regular contact with all Fairview Missionaries. The first meeting will be held in late January 2018.

Updated letters from our missions/missionaries will soon be posted in our Missions Notebook on the coffee table in the foyer, including photos. Inserts in the bulletin each week suggest various missions to pray for; please keep these people in your prayers.

If any member wishes to participate in a special mission event, locally or out of the area, Fairview encourages participation and would want to support it in prayer and possibly in other ways.

- ▶ Men and women from our church have continued their service for Good Works, working faithfully each month to bring the home for a family up to better living conditions.
- ► FEPC has been collecting food and donations for the Glenmore Food Pantry and also for the Salvation Army, with these being a focal point of the Vacation Bible School program over the summer.
- ► The Deacons sponsored an Angel Tree this year for Christmas, with gifts being sent to the Salvation Army out of the Glenmoore Food Pantry.

Our prayer is that we will continue to be a mission-minded church every year, giving generously to those in need and those who are in full-time service of Christ.

Worship & Music

The Worship and Music Committee is responsible for the planning and support of Fairview Evangelical Presbyterian Church's worship services and the music which is an integral part of worship. This includes the sanctuary and furnishings, music, instruments and support staff. We believe our focus of worship is God. We strive to structure worship so that He is honored in every aspect. We worship Him through the spoken Word, prayer, Christian education and music. Fairview's worship services generally follow a traditional format, however, we occasionally include more contemporary music. The goal is to support and enhance the worship experience and support the pastor's sermons and chosen scriptures.

The following events and items are significant for 2017:

- Two Cantatas were presented by the Senior Choir during the Easter and Christmas worship services under the capable leadership of our music director Clark Lash. "Wondrous Love" by Benjamin Harlan for Easter and "Festival of Lessons & Carols" by John Leavitt for Christmas. Both cantatas were accompanied by a small orchestra.
- On December 17th at 4:00 PM we held a Messiah Sing Along in the sanctuary. Members of the community were invited to come and sing along or listen to the Messiah performance accompanied by an orchestra and professional soloists. A reception was held in the foyer following the performance.
- This year we had two Christmas Eve services at 11:00 AM and 7:00 PM which were well attended.

Special thanks to all who assist in the various responsibilities in support of worship. Since Pastor Mark's retirement we have been blessed to have Dennis Lesher preach and coordinate our worship services and speakers. We are thankful for Clark Lash and his music leadership in worship on Sunday mornings. The choir members joyfully put in many hours of practice to bring glory to God. Thanks to Carolyn Thompson and her team who prepare the communion elements and to Hob Pusey and his team of ushers who have assisted with the worship services. We also recognize and thank our dedicated sound system engineer Roy Adler and his team at the sound board and Adrienne Boyance and the team who coordinate the power point slides for the sermon notes.

Stewardship

Stewardship is caring for what God has given us--- which includes the gift of life, as well as our loved ones, friends, livelihoods and church family.

As fruitful stewards of Fairview Evangelical Presbyterian Church, we are all called to contribute beyond the monetary. Giving freely of our time and talent is essential to our ongoing ability to grow in the Lord and support Fairview and its community outreach goals.

As we seek to call a new pastor, Session is asking members to help us "Grow in the Gap!" This little phrase simply means we need to keep growing during this time of pastoral transition. Trustees

In 2017, the Trustees continued to oversee the maintenance and capital improvements of Fairview Evangelical Presbyterian Church and the manse. We monitored church and cemetery finances and financial reporting, and investments

Bill Mecaughey remained Trustee President and Matt Steiginga continued in the VP/Financial role. Steve Chambers again chaired the Property Committee, whose members include John Keeler, Don Titus and John Gyrath. John also serves as Trustee Secretary. Celia Weber is our Cemetery Chairperson. Celia, Don and John Gyrath comprise a newly-formed Cemetery Committee.

Finance

Our Finance Committee oversight owes an ongoing debt to Treasurer Deb Burdy, whose financial expertise and meeting participation provides much benefit.

Fairview's general fund balance stabilized during 2017, after having fallen to its lowest level in over 25 years during 2016. See the accompanying 2017 financial statements for further details.

The 2016 bequests have been invested in a Vanguard short-term bond fund.

Fairview hosted 42 students from Windsor Christian Academy for 2016-17; however, the Academy had sufficient space for its students in the 2017-18 year.

Cemetery

Phil Harvey was appointed cemetery custodian effective June 2017, and has worked closely with the Trustees. Phil has done a fabulous job in organizing the cemetery records, overseeing burials, proposing new pricing and revising policies and procedures. In 2018, Phil has been asked to research, acquire and implement appropriate software to automate Fairview's cemetery records.

Property

In the first quarter of 2017, Fairview hired a new building caretaker, Bill Finch. Bill has done an excellent job in addressing a variety of repairs and maintenance at the church and manse.

In 2017, the Trustees completed the second phase of the steeple leakage remediation, which included interior sanctuary repairs. The exterior crown moldings on the front face of the church were replaced. Projecting band joints on the church exterior were sealed. Water-damaged sections of the front wall interior and sanctuary ceiling above the balcony were professionally repaired by a local contractor and repainted by Bill Finch. Water run-off that was destabilizing the front steps has been successfully remedied.

Phase II repairs, originally expected to cost upwards of \$25K, were completed for approximately \$17K. A special thanks goes to Don Titus for overseeing both phases of the successful steeple repairs.

To help fund the Phase II effort, under Celia's leadership, the Trustees raised approximately \$7K through a targeted "umbrella" campaign. The congregation's generous campaign response was appreciated.

The Trustees sponsored and worked with Patrick Finch as he completed his Eagle Scout project, which resulted in his building 8 well designed and crafted picnic tables. The tables are in the carriage shed.

The Trustees sponsored two successful 2017 workdays during which several indoor and outdoor cleaning and revitalization projects were accomplished.

We again wish to commend Elder Roy Adler for a fine job in spearheading Fairview's 2018 budget.

We pray for the congregation's faithful stewardship in helping sustain Fairview's ministries, particularly during our transition to a new pastor.
